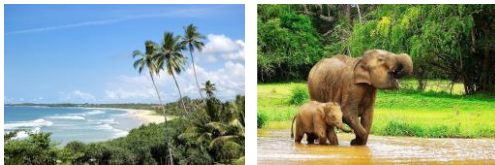

Day 4 - Nuwara Eliya to Yala

150 km (93 mi) in 4 Hours (approximately)

Start your descent from highlands toward the southern coast. Yala National Park is the most visited and second largest national park in Sri Lanka.

Kataragama Temple

Kataragamam temple in Kataragama, Sri Lanka, is a temple complex dedicated to Buddhist guardian deity Kataragama deviyo and Hindu War God Murugan. It is one of the few religious sites in Sri Lanka that is venerated by the Buddhists, Hindus, Muslims and the Vedda people. For most of the past millennia, it was a jungle shrine difficult to access; today it is accessible easily.

Safari tour in Yala

44 species of mammals are resident in Yala National Park, and it has one of the highest leopard densities in the world. 25 individual leopards are estimated to roam in Block I. The elephant herd of Yala contains 300-350 individuals
